## Programme of Study

The goal of the master programme is to impart a broad knowledge of Europe and the European Union.

As an international programme with all classes taught exclusively in English, its courses are designed around the dimensions of border regions, regional integration and development and external relations of the EU.

The Master of Arts in European Studies is a full-time 2 year degree and is offered in cooperation with the University of Southern Denmark.

A special aspect of our study programme is the emphasis on the role of regions and the regional particularities of Europe in a political, socio-economical, and cultural context. This emphasis highlights possibilities for cooperation across borders.

### Tuition Fees

The University of Flensburg charges no tuition fee; there is an administrative fee of approx. 100 Euro per semester, which also covers the use of public transport.

### Admission Requirements

Requirements for admission are a successfully completed Bachelor's degree in economics, social sciences, business, public administration, European studies, or in a similar field, and proof of adequate English proficiency.

### Application Procedure and Deadline

Your application should include the following materials:

1. Application form
2. A certified and translated copy of your high-school graduation certificate
3. A certified and translated copy of your Bachelor's degree
4. A certified and translated copy of the transcripts of your academic records
5. English proficiency test\*
6. Curriculum Vitae
7. Motivation letter (1 - 1.5 pages)
