



How to scan PDFs on Android


1. First look for the "Drive" app on your phone, you can use the search feature to find it



2. Once in the app, click on the camera icon on the bottom right to start scanning. Place the document in the frame, it will automatically start scanning it




3. You can continue scanning more pages after one has been scanned by clicking the "plus" button




4. Using the bottom panel you can:


- Retake any pages by clicking "Retake"
- Change the crop, filter, rotation or delete a page by clicking the respective buttons



5. Once you are satisfied with all scanned pages, you can save the scanned document by clicking "Done" on the top right hand side



6. Now you can set a name and format of the document to be saved with. Once satisfied we click "Save" on the top right hand side





7. You can now share and send this document like any other document by clicking the three dots next to it's name
